

Notes for the MRCP(UK) Part 1 Examination

- The MRCP(UK) Part 1 Examination consists of two papers held on the same day. The date and times are stated on your Admission Document. Each paper is 3 hours in duration. Candidates may not leave before the end of either of the 2 papers and will not be admitted to any Paper if they arrive more than 30 minutes after the Examination has started, unless exceptionally with the express permission of the invigilator(s).
- Whilst we try to ensure average room temperatures at all examination venues, candidates are advised to bring suitable clothing to ensure they are comfortable during the examination as conditions can vary.
- You must take your Admission Document and identification with you for both papers. Having taken your seat, leave your Admission Document and identification on your desk. Invigilators will check your documents against a register before or just after the start of each examination paper. Please note that your Admission Document will be collected during the second paper of the examination.
- Refreshments and food cannot be guaranteed at any of the venues therefore you are advised to bring drinking water and or food should you not wish to use local outlets.
- Please read the section of the *MRCP(UK) Regulations and Information for Candidates* entitled – *Attendance at, and conduct during, the MRCP(UK) Part 1 and Part 2 Written Examination*. The Regulations can be viewed on our website.

Results information

- Examination results will be mailed approximately 4 weeks after the examination. Results will be displayed in the public results area of the MRCP(UK) website for candidates who have opted-in on their application. Any candidate who registers for an online account will be able to view their results within the secure online account area, *My MRCP(UK)*.
- Result release dates are published on the *Exam Dates* section of the website. Please do not contact us about the release date of results; check the website for up to date information.
- If you have any queries, or wish to change your address after the examination, please contact your administration office in writing or by email. Candidates with an online account may also change their address through their account at any time.
