

**Specialty Certificate Examination (SCE) in Acute Medicine 2017  
Selected Examination Metrics**

The 2017 SCE in Acute Medicine was sat by 291 candidates of which 128 were self-declared UK trainees. Candidates who did not declare their training details are reported as 'Other' (163).

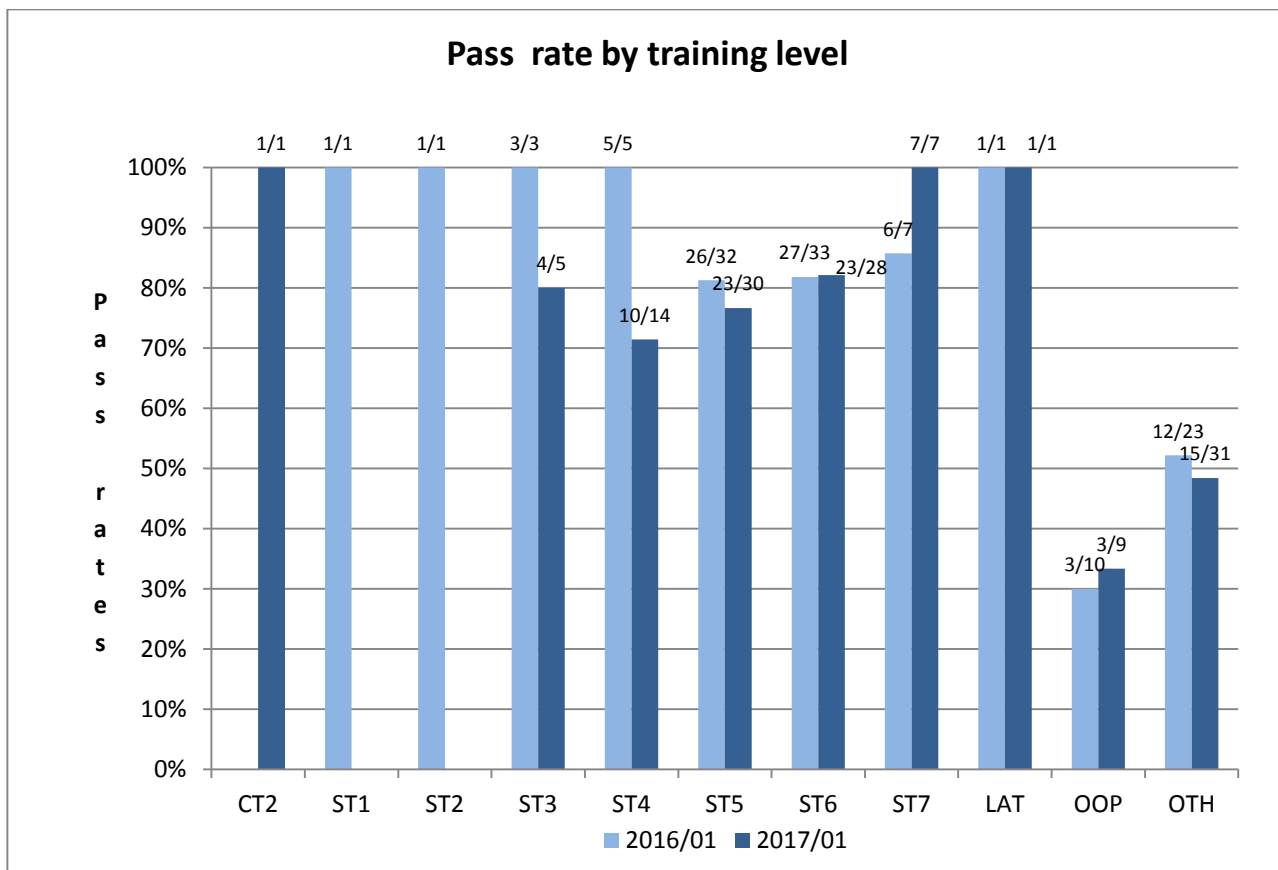
**Pass Mark**

The pass mark for this examination was established by using the Hofstee compromise method which combines the mean scores of the standard setting group with UK trainees' performance.

For the 2017 Acute Medicine examination the pass mark was set at 59.4% (114/192).

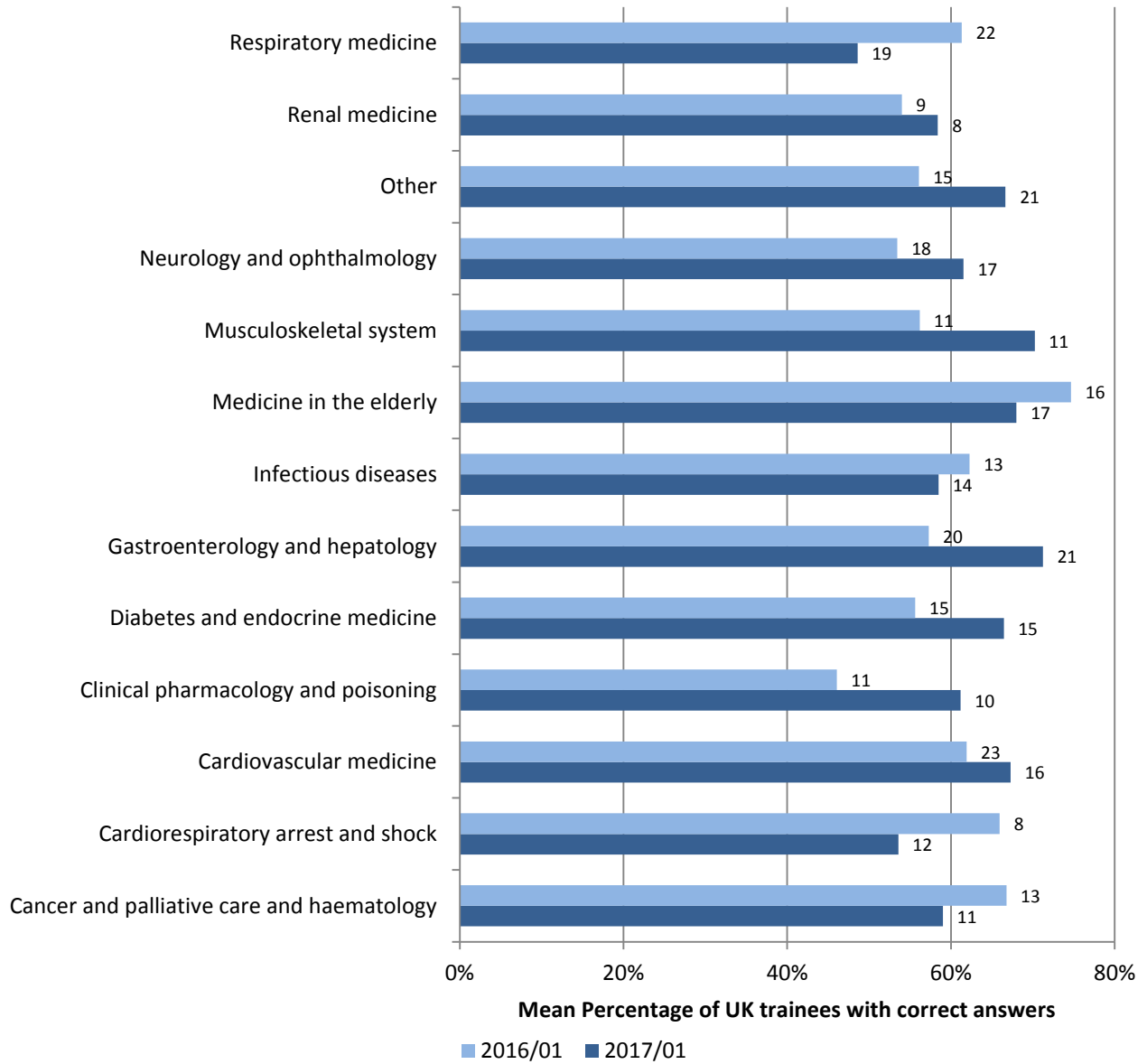

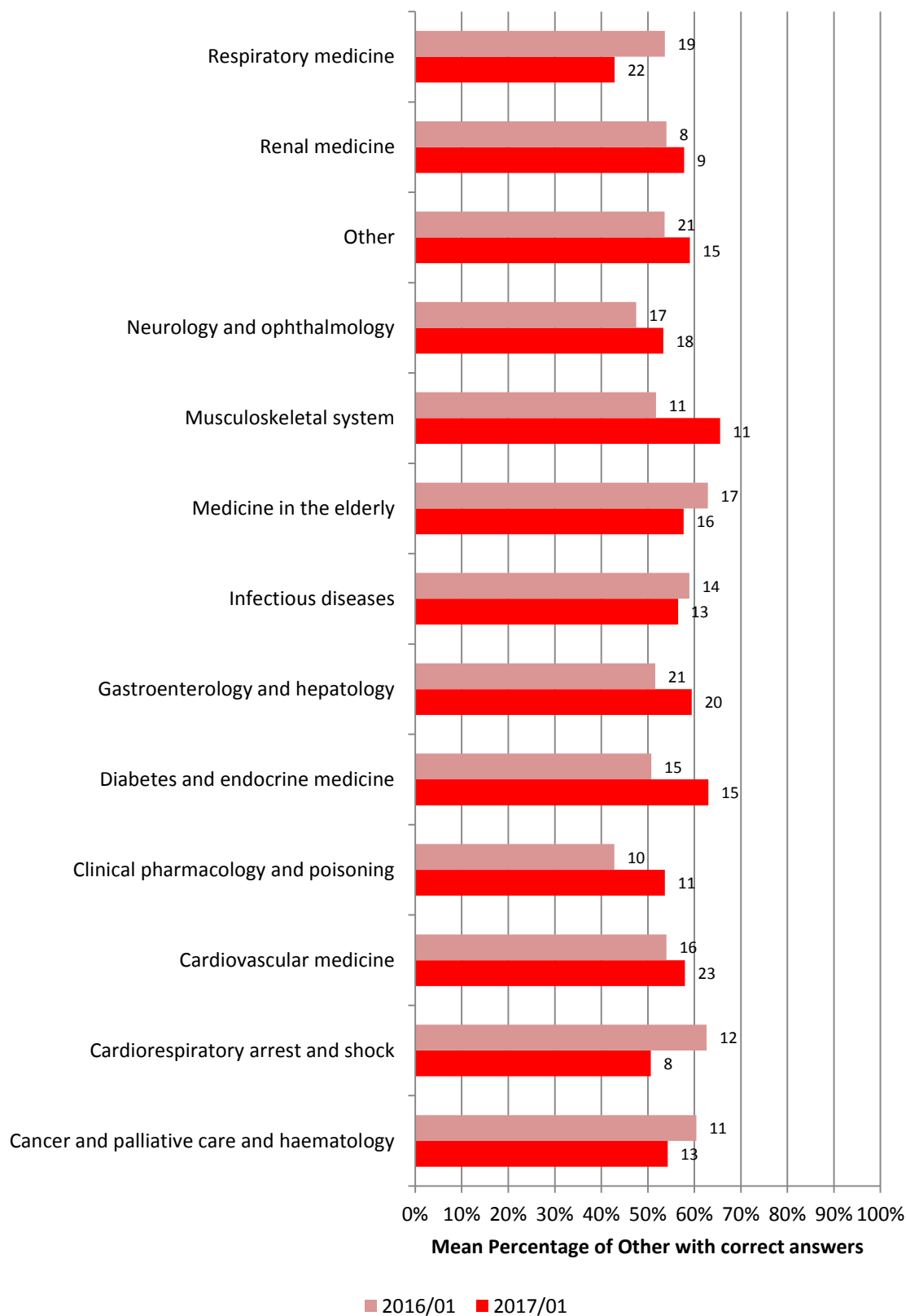
