

**Specialty Certificate Examination (SCE) in Rheumatology 2017
Selected Examination Metrics**

The 2017 SCE in Rheumatology was sat by 145 candidates of which 77 were self-declared UK trainees. Candidates who did not declare their training details are reported as 'Other' (68).

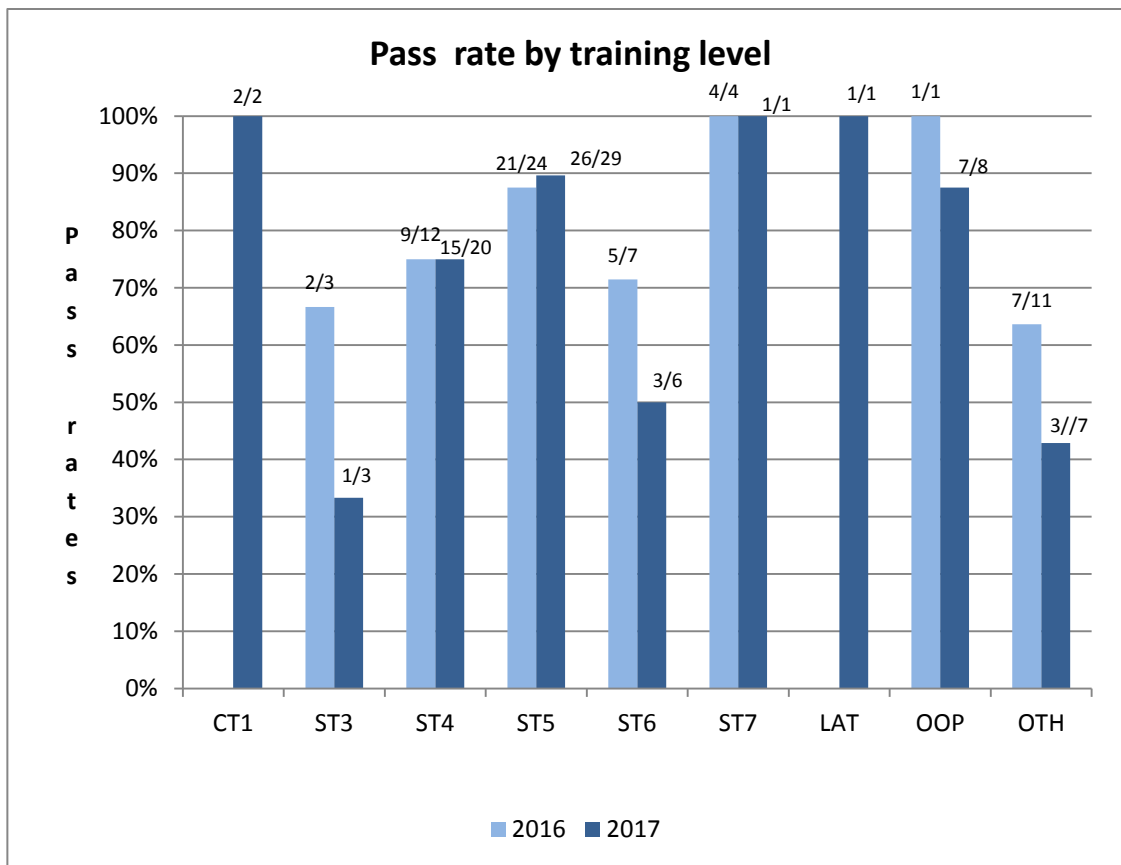
Pass Mark

The pass mark for this examination was established by using the Hofstee compromise method which combines the mean scores of the standard setting group with UK trainees' performance.

For the 2017 Rheumatology examination the pass mark was set at 69.7% (138/198).

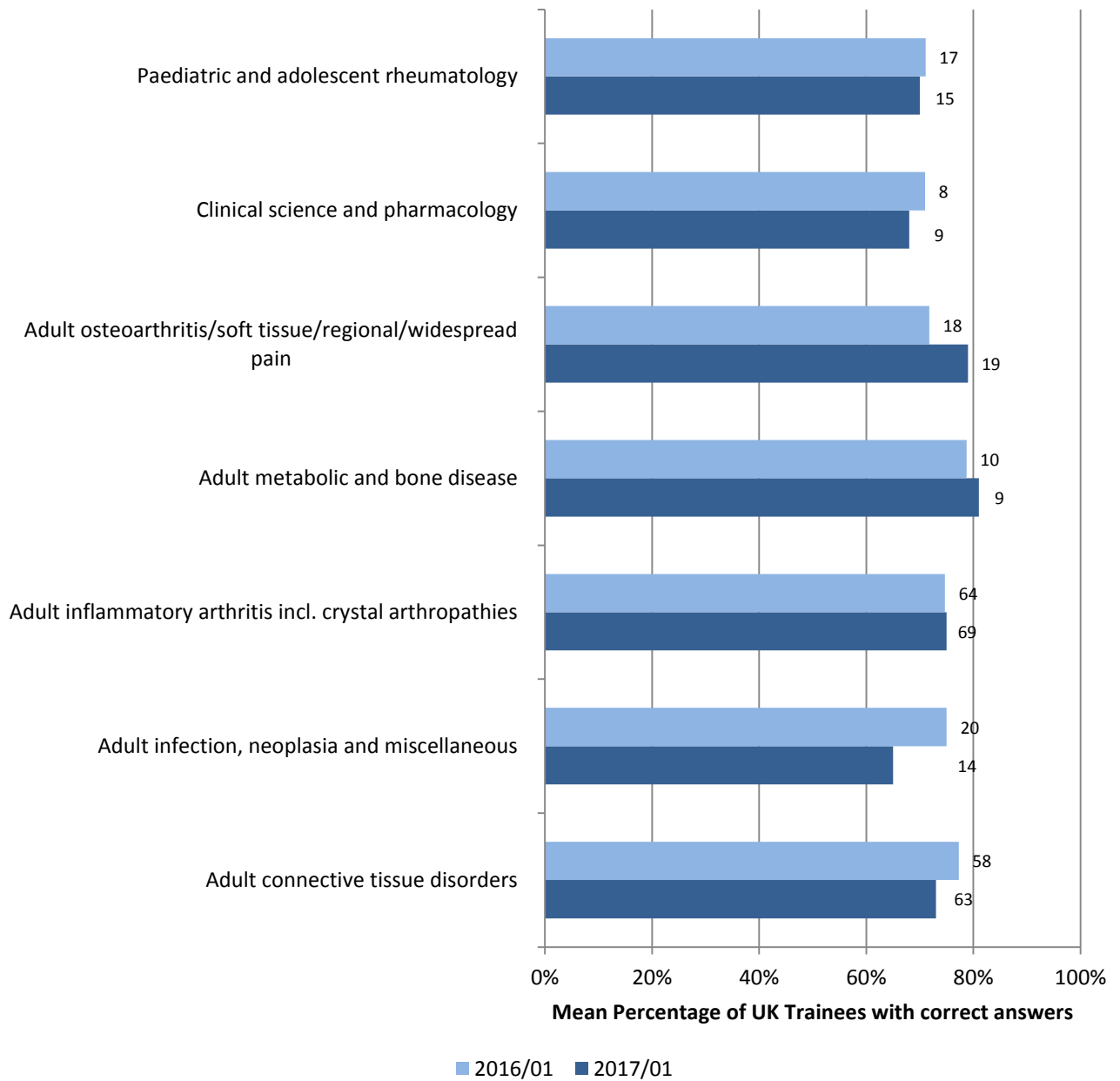

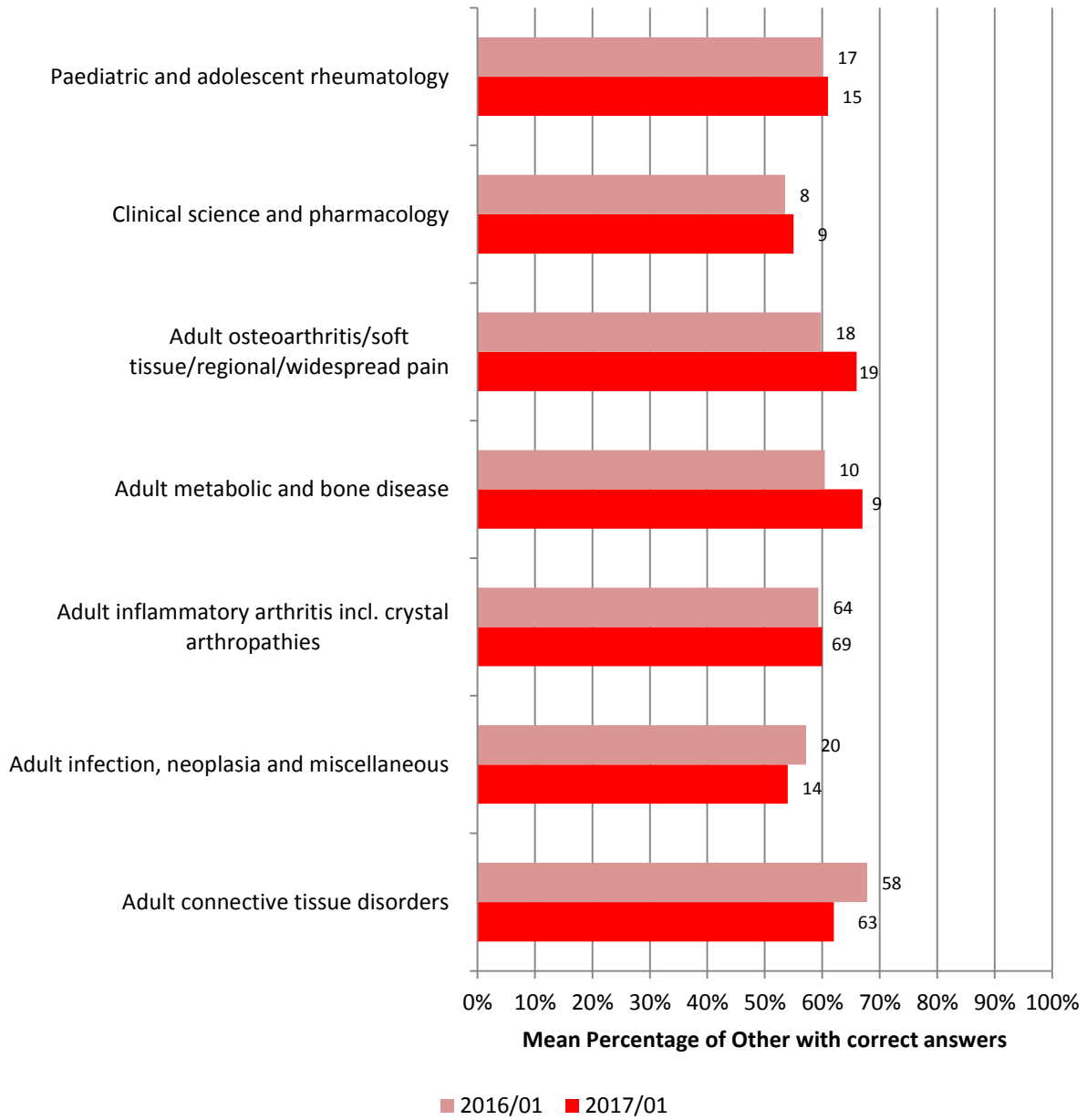
* The numbers at the top of the bars are the number of trainees passing/sitting
