Summary of timings at each Station

- The start and finish of each 20 minute period is clearly signaled by a bell or equivalent.
- A hand held clock will be provided at each Station. Examiners should take responsibility for timing the interactions within each Station and encounter.
- Within each Station, and at each encounter, the following timings apply to the amounts of time that the candidate should spend with the patient and examiner.
- Examiners should inform candidates of the passage of time during each encounter, by providing time warnings ("You have x minutes left") at the time indicated.
